

Terms and conditions

- The promoter is the British Equestrian Federation, Stoneleigh Park, Kenilworth, Warwickshire, CV8 2RH (the "BEF").
- There are no restrictions to the number of entries one person can make.
- Entry to the prize draw is £5 per ticket.
- No tickets can be sold to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16 years. When contacted, the prize winners must provide proof of age. If a ticket is sold unknowingly to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16 they will be exempt from the raffle and will forfeit their prize.
- Monies raised by this raffle will go to support Equestrian Team GBR and will be distributed by the British Equestrian Federation.
- Payment for participation in the raffle can be made by cheque payable to "British Equestrian Federation" or by cash.
- Raffle tickets will be entered into the draw when the whole payment is received.
- The BEF accepts no responsibility for raffle tickets which are lost, damaged, illegible or from which the prize-winner cannot be identified.
- Tickets must be kept as proof of purchase.
- 6 raffle tickets will be drawn randomly.
- First prize will be awarded to the first entry drawn at random by an independent, supervised individual. The remaining prizes will then be awarded to the subsequent entries drawn. The decision of the independent, supervised individual will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
