



SELECTION POLICY FOR LE LION D'ANGERS OCTOBER 2019

Places available

It is likely there will be a limit to how many horses will be allowed from Great Britain

6 year olds: Normally 3, 6yr olds

7 year olds: Normally 12, 7yr olds.

The following Policy will be adopted by the Senior Selection Committee in the allocation of these places.

Any horse/rider combination wishing to be considered for selection must have sent their application to the BE office by the application date. In the interest of fairness this date will be strictly adhered to and it is up to the rider or his representative to ensure that an application has been received.

Selection will take place as soon as possible after the application date. Once selection has been completed all applicants will be notified. The selected riders, and a list of reserve riders in order, will be drawn up.

Selection will only be done from horses which are qualified at the time of application and hold a current up-to-date FEI passport. The qualifications are:

6 year olds: Minimum one CIC* with FEI qualifying result (see Le Lion d'Angers schedule for specific qualifications).

7 year olds: See rule book for CCI** (see Le Lion d'Angers schedule for specific qualifications).

Selection will be done from results. Each horse must have shown good and consistent performances in all three phases.

The Selectors will take into consideration the level of a horse's experience, also the quality of each run and **not** the number of runs that a horse has had.

Horses are judged on their own merit with the aim of sending the best possible representation to these Championships. Therefore a rider and/or an owner could have two or more horses selected.



If two horses have similar and comparable results the horse ridden by the rider highest in the FEI World Ranking will be selected, or, if one of these horses is British bred it will have priority.

The Selectors reserve the right to change any of the above criteria should this be deemed necessary.
